What are the Business Achievement Awards?

The Business Achievement Awards (BAAs) are a member education program focused on helping members to **develop** leadership skills, **expand** business knowledge, and **contribute** in their school and community. Participating in the program allows members to **engage** more deeply with FBLA and **prepare** for future leadership opportunities while **earning** national recognition.

How It Works

Achieve two levels of recognition by completing courses to learn more about FBLA, develop leadership skills, and focus on a chosen business skill or content area to further develop.

Level 1: EXPLORE AWARD (2–3 Hours)

Get introduced to the foundations of FBLA as they learn about FBLA Middle School, explore how to make the most of their experience, and begin developing essential leadership skills.

Level 2: ASPIRE AWARD (5–6 Hours)

Take a deep dive into a business skill or content area. This award can be earned by completing one or more of the following online courses:

- Data Science Foundations and Exploration Lab
